The Empowerment Academy Leadership Awards are an opportunity to let your enthusiasm for the pageant industry shine! The competition elements are designed to not only showcase your leadership in the pageant industry, but help you to polish your skills as you continue on your journey.

Participating in the Empowerment Academy Leadership Awards competition will be a great addition to your pageant and professional resume. This is not a pageant! You are participating in a competition that will select winners that will be recognized for their leadership in and passion for the pageant industry.

The competition will be held in a virtual format, which allows for greater accessibility and participation. Appropriate accommodations will be provided upon request. Awards given will be determined by number of applications received.

Winners will receive a plaque, commemorative crown pin, scholarship to the Empowerment Academy and an opportunity to be a guest on an episode of Empowerment Academy TV.

All participants will receive a certificate and be included in the 2022 Empowerment Academy Showcase Magazine.

Contestant Criteria

- Girls, women and transwomen ages 12+ are eligible to apply
- All abilities welcome, and accommodations will be provided if necessary
- There are no residency requirements. Contestants from around the globe are welcome to compete, but should be English proficient or have access to adequate translation services
- Must comply by the Code of Conduct and must sign the Agreement for Participation

Competition Elements

Interview (Contestants will participate in a recorded interview via Zoom) 1-page essay "How I have benefited from pageantry and how we can make the industry better"

Contestant pageant resume/fact sheet

A creative piece in the medium of your choice showcasing the positive benefits of pageantry

How to Enter

Submit an application at DarcyCastro.com. Upon full payment, you will receive a confirmation email of your acceptance and instructions on how to schedule your interview.

You must submit the following materials to Info@DarcyCastro.com **no later than 5pm ET Friday, February 4**:

- Essay
- Resume/fact sheet
- Creative piece
- Headshot (for reference, not a judged element)

Judging

The Empowerment Academy panel of experts will score each contestant's full competition package. Judges decisions are final. Criteria is as follows:

- Effort and enthusiasm
- Evidence of positive impact on the pageant community
- Leadership skills and/or potential for leadership
- Communication skills
- Passion for the industry and improving pageantry
- Polish, poise and professionalism

Pricing

- * Interviews will be scheduled as soon as all materials are received, and must be scheduled by February 9th
- * Final results will be announced February 18th
